

Purpose of the symposium?

These scholarships are critical to the University's efforts to recruit the highest achieving students into our program.



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ABOUT THE SCHOOL OF POLYMERS AND HIGH PERFORMANCE MATERIALS

The School of Polymers and High Performance Materials consists of 11 fulltime faculty members, 5 active emeritus faculty members, and 1 research faculty member. Of these 17 individuals, seven are particularly associated with the coatings education and research program: Lochhead, Rawlins, Storey, Azoulay, Simon, Patton, and Thames.

The vast majority of students within the School of Polymers and High Performance Materials are full time. These students pursue programs of study leading to the degrees of Bachelor of Science in Polymer Science, Bachelor of Science in Polymer Science and Engineering, Master of Science in Polymer Science and Engineering, and Doctor of Philosophy in Polymer Science and Engineering. The undergraduate and graduate programs receive equal emphasis, and the enrollment for undergraduate students has shown unprecedented growth in recent years with the addition of our Polymer Science and Engineering Degree. Our undergraduate program has increased by almost 80% over the last five years (see chart on left). A greater proportion of the undergraduate curriculum (as compared to the graduate curriculum) is devoted strictly to coatings education. A larger proportion of B.S. graduates accept their first jobs in the coatings industry.
